

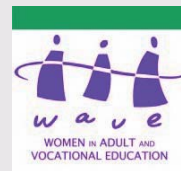

Accommodation is available at The Women's College and registration details are available on the AWE and WAVE websites.

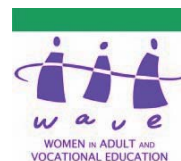
